Paper Structure

The extended abstracts must follow the structure outlined below:

TITLE

maximum 15 words

Provide a concise and descriptive title that reflects the research focus and key contribution of your extended abstract.

Author details

Do not include the authors in the extended abstract.

The names of all contributing authors should be added to the EasyChair submission.

Keywords

4 - 6 keywords

Provide keywords that capture the core themes, methods, or concepts of your research

INTRODUCTION

150 - 200 words

Introduce the research problem, its significance, and the primary objective(s) of the study.

Clearly state the research question(s) and briefly outline the contribution to existing literature or practice.

METHODOLOGY	150 - 200 words	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Describe the research design, including the methodology (e.g., quantitative, qualitative, mixed methods), data sources, sample size, and analytical techniques. <input type="checkbox"/> Specify how the approach addresses the research question(s) and ensures rigor and validity.
RESULTS AND DISCUSSION	300 - 500 words	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Present the key findings of your study and interpret their significance. <input type="checkbox"/> Highlight patterns, relationships, or outcomes, and discuss their alignment with or deviation from existing literature.
CONCLUSIONS AND IMPLICATIONS FOR THEORY AND PRACTICE	150 - 200 words	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Summarize the main conclusions drawn from your findings. <input type="checkbox"/> Explain how your research advances theoretical understanding and/or informs practical applications. <input type="checkbox"/> Provide actionable insights or recommendations for researchers, practitioners, policymakers, or managers derived from your findings. <input type="checkbox"/> Emphasize the relevance and feasibility within the context of your study's focus. <input type="checkbox"/> Avoid introducing new results in this section; focus on key findings and stress their impact.
